To celebrate 35th anniversary of the
Greater West Bloomfield Historical Society
September 13, 1 to 4 p.m.**

The public is invited to a free Apple Pie & Ice Cream Social sponsored by the Greater West Bloomfield Historical Society to celebrate its 35th anniversary on Sunday, September 13, 1 to 4 p.m. at the Orchard Lake Museum, Orchard Lake Road at Long Lake Road.

To the harmonies of the barbershop quartet Coda Honor, visitors of all ages will be entertained on the museum grounds with features reminiscent of the West Bloomfield area's past, including two of its biggest farm products – apples and wool – in the pioneer days from the 1840s to the end of that century.

Guests will be served ice cream and apple pie in tribute to the West Bloomfield area's many former apple orchards.

DuAnne Sonnevile of Orchard Lake will show the process of taking wool already shorn from sheep through every step to a final product of wool.

There also will be vintage lawn games for children, a display of outboard motors from the early 1900s and demonstrations of old farm implements.
